Psionic Medical Analysis, What is it all about?

Dr Andrew Sikorski was introduced to complementary medicine during his NHS GP training at the St Michael's Hospital Obstetric Unit, where he observed a birth using only acupuncture and meditation/hypnosis techniques. Subsequently he studied acupuncture and homeopathy under the tutelage of Drs George Lewith, Philip Jackson and Farley Spink. He has held posts in the NHS Homeopathic Hospitals in London, Glasgow and Royal Tunbridge Wells and through his long career has gained a broad understanding of holistic medicine. Andrew was chair of the British Holistic Medical Association and has served on the Councils of the Faculty of Homeopathy and BMA (SE Coast).
